

# Lost Power?

- Utilities - Has your service been interrupted? Check this first.
  - A Tripped Breaker could be to blame. See below examples of tripped breakers and how to properly reset.
- ⇒ Locate the tripped breaker. Breakers have tripped when they are “out of line”. See example below.
- ⇒ To re-set the breaker, turn it to the “off” position, then turn it back to the “on” position.



- It could be a GFI or GFCI outlet that needs to be reset. To locate the outlet with the tripped GFI, look for the one with a small button popped out. Remember, when a GFI trips, it will trip any and all outlets connected to that GFI. Most kitchen and bathrooms in new homes have multiple (visible) GFI outlets, so it shouldn't be too hard to find the GFI that's tripped in one of these rooms. You may even need to check the garage and outside for these outlets. **Once you have located the outlet with the tripped GFI, simply push the button back into place.**
